- Riders will jump 14 fences in total, 8 at the lower height and 6 at the higher height.
- The higher part of the course will be timed.
- 3 refusals will result in elimination.
- Team members will ride in succession.
- Individuals will ride after the teams have jumped.
- Ages as of 1st September 2011.
- Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.
